

Klondike Sled Provisions

The list below contains the provisions to have on the sled for the competition. The Northwest Mounted Police inspected each prospector before allowing entry into the Klondike Territory; this was for prospector safety. Your sled will be inspected and deductions made for missing items. “Be Prepared” and make sure your patrol is prepared for the event. The minimum weight of the sled is to be 30 pounds.

1. tent
2. patrol flag
3. patrol roster
4. clip board
5. two (2) six (6) foot staves
6. splints
7. aluminum foil
8. trash bag
9. tools for sled repair
10. lunch
11. saw buck for sawing wood
12. compass
13. dry wood
14. ground cloth and/or poncho
15. eight (8) sections of rope six (6) feet long
16. four (4) sections of rope twelve (12) feet long (suitable for lashing)
17. well stocked first-aid kit
18. camp stove with fuel
19. three (3) gallons of water
20. cups for each patrol member
21. fire starting material (**no chemical fire starters or lighters, no liquid fuel, magnesium or steel wool, etc.**)
22. pencil and pad
23. pocket knife (**must have Totin’ Chip**)
24. hand axe in sheath (**again, must have Totin’ Chip**)
25. bow saw (**Totin’ Chip**)
26. mallet for splitting wood
27. Scout handbook and Scout fieldbook
28. cooking utensils
29. blanket and/or sleeping bag
30. bag for gold
31. fire bucket (**#10 can will do**)
32. dry clothing in waterproof (gallon size ziplock) container for each patrol member
33. B-PKit Outdoor Essentials (See below)

The B-P Kit Outdoor Essentials

When in the outdoors, every Scout must “Be Prepared” for ordinary camp activities like lighting a fire or cutting rope, as well as emergencies like getting lost or severe bleeding. The items below form a kit (with the exception of extra clothing, everything is an outdoor essential as described in the Scout Handbook) to help a Scout “Be Prepared.” These items can be carried in a waist or fanny pack and should be carried with you always when you are in an outdoor setting.

Whistle

Large, heavy mil garbage bag

Matches/fire starter (matches in a waterproof safe)

Fire tinder

Pencil and pad

Emergency food bar or trail mix

First aid kit

Duct tape

Needle and thread

Water bottle

Flashlight

Sunglasses

Head protection

Sun block (SPF of at least 15)

During the Klondike, patrols with these kits will be awarded gold.
