

Gold Distribution

The distribution of gold will be as follows. Twenty pieces of gold will be awarded for lunch and lunch preparation; lunch is to be cooked in the town where the patrol is at the lunch period. Clean-up is part of the lunch. See the rules section for what type(s) of lunch will earn the patrol gold.

Sled provisions are worth 50 pieces of gold. As with the gold rush, patrols and their sleds must **Be Prepared** in order to participate. Each sled will be inspected and gold will be awarded by how much equipment each team has from the required list.

With the exception of the town(s) designated as the mother lode, the amount of gold to be earned will be thirty (30) pieces. No patrol yell or flag will reduce this amount. Non participation by all patrol members and no written patrol roster will also reduce the gold count.

The Klondike quiz is worth forty (40) pieces of gold. Each incorrect answer will reduce the amount.

Mounties have discretion up to twenty (20) pieces of gold. The questions asked by Mounties are their choice and they make the decision as to how much to give and the rules they have for distributing gold.

The skit is worth thirty (30) pieces of gold. The skit is a troop skit, one per troop. Each patrol in the troop will be awarded the same amount of gold for the skit.

The governor and/or his designee can award gold at his/her discretion.

As you can see, there is gold to be earned and by **being prepared**, each patrol has the opportunity to succeed.
